

# SUZUKI PIANO PLAY-A-THON

Dear Piano Teachers,

This year's play-a-thon will be held on Sunday 29 April – earlier than usual. Suzuki Music will make a donation of 50% of the registration fee per student to the charity Australian Children's Music Foundation (ACMF) on behalf of our piano students. Please give this event your full support and encourage all students to be involved in this very worthwhile project. All students who are participating in this event (at a public venue or in a home studio) must register for a fee of \$25 per student, to a maximum of \$50 per family.

If you are entering your students for a public venue you must be available to assist or provide a proxy who is able to assist in your place. At most venues the play-a-thon will be run as a concert and students will watch the concert when they are not performing. It is expected that students stay for the entire hour that they are allocated to.

### What is the ACMF?

The Australian Children's Music Foundation (ACMF) is a not-for-profit organisation inspiring creativity and imagination by providing weekly music education classes and instruments to disadvantaged children and youth at risk throughout Australia.

### SCHOOLS

Across Australia, a dedicated team of ACMF teachers motivate, educate and inspire disadvantaged children and youth in free, long-term weekly music programs. Over 75% of Australian Public Schools do not have access to a music teacher, depriving them of the many benefits of music education. The ACMF is determined to change this. Since our inception, we have provided over 224,400 free music lessons of every kind. We have donated over \$830,000 worth of instruments. We are committed to delivering long-term programs in every state and territory in Australia.

### JUVENILE JUSTICE

We hold weekly programs in detention centres across Australia, mentoring young men and women and expanding their opportunities, confidence and resilience through the magic of music. Because our class-sizes are small, the effect of our mentoring programs is powerful, making a significant impact on the well-being of young men and women.

Malvern Central (10.30 – 11.30, 11.30 – 12.30, 12.30 – 1.30, 1.30 – 2.30, 2.30 – 3.30)

Penleigh & Essendon Grammar School – Woollacott Hall, Essendon (1.30 – 2.30, 2.30 – 3.30)

### Time limits per student at Westfield Doncaster and Malvern Central

Playing repertoire in Books 1 to 2: Less than 3 minutes per student

Books 2 to 4: Less than 5 minutes per student

Book 4+: Less than 8 minutes per student

### Time limits per student at Penleigh & Essendon GS

Books 1 – 3: Less than 3 minutes per student

Books 4+: 2 pieces total (regardless of duration) per student

At some venues, students will be allocated to a concert program order and at other they will be allocated a number on arrival. Students need to bring with them a written list of the pieces they wish to play on the day. It is important that everyone has a chance to participate and that **the performances are all at concert standard**.

Funds will be raised through registration fees (\$25 per student) as well as any students choosing to obtain additional sponsorships. Funds raised by sponsorship must be sent to the Suzuki Music office via Suzuki Piano teachers by Friday 11 May 2018.
