### Concert Information for teachers

- a maximum item duration of 4 minutes per item applies at all venues
- each item is one piece or one movement of a longer piece (except where two short movements are generally played together as one item)
- **Erasmus School:** Maximum of 6 items per teacher per concert (to a maximum duration of 12 minutes per teacher per concert)
- **Suzuki Music office:** Maximum of 5 items per teacher per concert (to a maximum duration of 10 minutes per teacher per concert)
- **PEGS:** No limit on number of items but maximum 4 minutes per item duration does apply
- Pieces that have a written piano accompaniment must be performed with an accompanist. Students may provide their own accompanist or use the accompanist provided at the venue. Rehearsals with the venue accompanists, listed above, are mandatory and must be arranged and paid for by the family prior to the concert day.
- Piano students may perform any piece from Book 1 Twinkle Theme (Var D) and beyond, but **pieces** must be performed **hands together**.
- Teachers may only submit students who are learning from them. This means siblings of students who learn with someone else must be submitted by their own teacher. In this instance, one teacher pays for the family and the other teacher writes this on their form so Suzuki staff members can cross check the applications.
- **All performers and their teacher must be 2022 financial members by the closing date and before this form is submitted.**
- **Teachers who are entering students must be available to assist on the day in concerts in which their students are allocated** unless a proxy name is provided to Suzuki Music with this application form.
- Concert fees are **not refundable, and are not able to be credited or transferred** for any reason after the form has been submitted to the office, including for non-financial students. Information about COVID isolation-related performer absences on the concert day will be forwarded to teachers closer to the concert day.
