PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Enrolments Close Friday 17 March 2017

Late applications may be accepted subject to payment of late fees. Late applications may cease to be accepted at any time without notice.

This professional development program is only open to teachers who have been accepted into or have completed a Suzuki teacher training program in any country. It is offered as a full program and pro rata rates are not available for partial attendance.

At WinterFestival Professional Development is offered for Suzuki teachers in

● Violin/Viola (combined) ● Cello ● Piano ● Flute ● Guitar ● Organ ● Voice ● Baby & Toddler Music

Enrolling in the Professional Development Program gives great value for money. Included in the one fee is:

- Over 11 hours of Professional Development sessions including tonalisation sessions for every instrument
- Catering included daily. Hot lunch (2 days), 'bakery' lunch (2 days); morning tea or afternoon tea daily
- Observation of student classes taken by leading guest tutors and local faculty
- Afternoon concert, Gala concert and Closing play ins and concerts.
- Many opportunities to discuss new ideas with your colleagues

Individual lessons (30 minutes) with visiting faculty are also available as an optional extra but places are limited and are allocated in order of receipt of forms from students and teachers.

The Professional Development Program commences on Tuesday 11 July and concludes on Saturday 15 July (plus 10 July for teachers enrolled in the Baby & Toddler Professional Development)

Cost

\$500 for teachers of violin/viola, cello, piano, guitar, organ and voice

\$500 for Baby & Toddler teachers who are not accredited or training on another instrument

\$640 for Baby & Toddler teachers who are accredited or training on another instrument

Late Application Fees apply to applications and/or payments received after Friday 17 March 2017. Teachers applying for funding from their school need to ensure their form and payment are received by the closing date or late fees will apply. Please note that a purchase order is not equivalent to payment being received.

Enrolment in the Professional Development program is only open to 2017 financial Suzuki teacher or teacher trainee members in Victoria or your local Suzuki Association.

2017 Professional Development Passport \$110

FOR Teacher or Teacher Trainee members of Suzuki Music in Victoria ONLY

Suzuki Music teacher members (Victoria only) who pay full fees to enrol in Festival 2017 are able to purchase an optional PD Passport for \$110 which enables them to register to attend **any** Professional Development instrument specific or all instruments session offered in Victoria in 2017 (excluding conferences, observation sessions, or festivals, primary, intermediate, advanced, viola conversion, special needs, ECE or other full training courses) free of charge (other than late fees which still apply). Please note that if you purchased the 2016-2017 PD Passport last year you should NOT purchase a new PD passport this year.

This offer is only available to teachers paying full fees to enrol in Festival 2017 and can only be taken up at the time of enrolment for Festival. The passport may not be taken up at any later stage during the year. The PD passport is not refundable or transferable for any reason.
