GRAND CONCERT REHEARSALS

All rehearsals for the Grand Concert are compulsory to ensure the safety of students and high musical standard on the concert day. Our large, massed items and instrumental group items will only work if the students have learnt what they need to do in terms of movement on and off the stage and the structure of the pieces. *If there is a rehearsal that your child cannot attend due to exceptional circumstances, please talk with your teacher and have them contact Suzuki Music to discuss this before registering for this event.*

REPERTOIRE TO BE PERFORMED

The instrument group repertoire list indicates the pieces being performed in the concert. Your child should practice the pieces on the list that they can already play – they do not need to learn any of the pieces beyond their current Suzuki piece.

All performers will participate in Twinkle and Thank You, Dr Suzuki. Music for Thank You, Dr Suzuki will be distributed to teachers shortly. Teachers will then give each student their allocated part. All students should learn their part from memory. Sheet music and reference recordings will be available.

WHAT TO WEAR TO PERFORM

As this is a very special concert, we want everyone looking their best! Please prepare the following 'uniform' well ahead so that there are to avoid any panic on concert day.

Concert clothes (as below) should be worn all day (including to rehearsals) on Sunday 31 August. Casual clothes can be worn to all other rehearsals.

Concert clothes should include:

- White or black concert appropriate top (that reaches the waist band of the bottoms) with black knee length or longer skirt or black dress pants. Please note that clothing must be plain colours only no patterns.
- OR completely white or black knee length or longer dress

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- Black socks or tights (or white tights for a white dress)
- Black shoes (no sneakers/runners/sport shoes) think school shoes or other formal shoes
- Performers may add a small touch of gold in the form of an accessory tie or handkerchief or clip or ribbon, for example. Please avoid yellow.

CAN MY CHILD PERFORM ON MORE THAN ONE INSTRUMENT?

Yes, they can. Please send Rosemary Fuller an email (rfuller@suzukimusic.org.au) after registering your child on their first instrument, with details of their 2nd instrument (instrument, current piece and book, teacher name). Please note, an adult may be needed to help a child who is performing on two instruments move from group to group during the concert. There is no additional fee to perform on two instruments.
